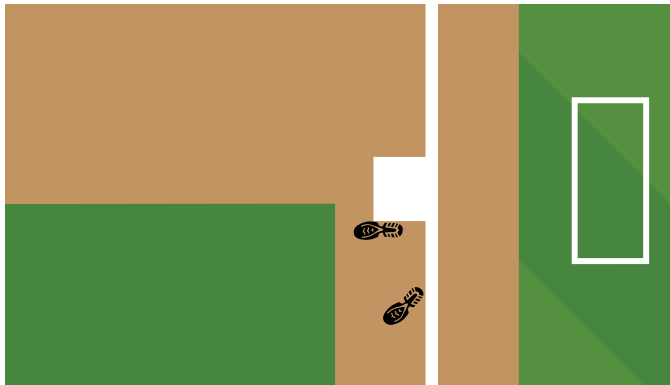


HOLDING RUNNER

Positioning to hold a runner at 1B for a LEFT handed fielder



1. Right foot is next to the base with the toes inside the bag (toward 2B)
2. Left foot does not have to be off the line - fielder can pick a comfortable position
3. Glove is held up and in the middle of the chest

NOTE:

- Keeping the right foot's toes inside the base makes it easier to tag with the whole glove in front of the base.
- The left foot does not have to be off the line because the LH fielder does not have to reach across their body with the glove to make a tag.



TAG IN FRONT OF THE BASE

Tagging with the whole glove in front of the base gives the fielder a better chance for an out call on a pickoff attempt.
