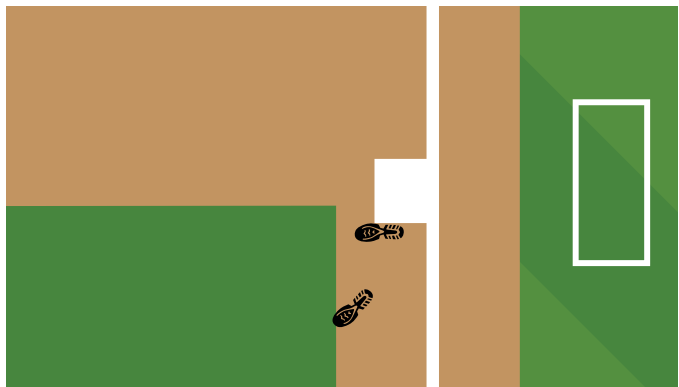


1B - HOLDING RUNNER - RIGHT HANDED FIELDER

**HOLDING RUNNER**


Positioning to hold a runner at 1B for a RIGHT handed fielder



1. Right foot is next to the base with the toes inside the bag (toward 2B)
2. Left foot is open and positioned toward the pitching rubber
3. Glove is held up and in the middle of the chest

**NOTE:**

- Keeping the right foot's toes inside the base makes it easier to tag with the whole glove in front of the base.
- Opening the toes of the left foot helps the fielder move to catch an errant throw on the glove side.



**STEP LEFT FOOT TOWARD PITCHING RUBBER**

The RH fielder steps their left foot toward the pitching rubber to get their glove closer to the base for a tag on a pick off play.
