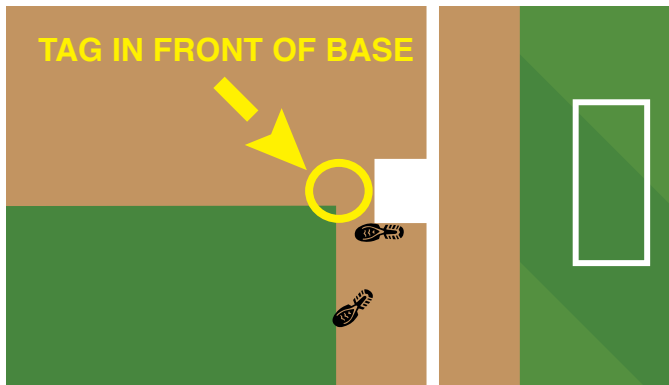


APPLYING TAG

Correct positioning helps the fielder tag the runner in a manner that gives them the best chance for an out call.



1. Toes of the right foot must be in front of the base to position the hips so they will facilitate a better angle to tag in front of the base
2. The RH fielder's left foot is set toward the pitching rubber which brings the glove 2-3 feet closer to the tag while waiting for pick-off attempt
3. The full glove should tag in front of the base



TAG IN FRONT OF THE BASE

Applying the tag with the glove completely in front of the base gives the fielder a better chance for an out call from the umpire.
